<p>2. Matters arising</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Forester Sub-committee – JP Has heard from Gary Smeeth that new Forester distribution co-ordinator is Elizabeth Johnson. JP has tried to make contact with her regarding the new arrangements w.e.f. June 2018. The next meeting of the Forester sub-committee is 21 May 18 (confirmation from CPC awaited). • Puddleduck Farm – SD to look into the matter with ABC enforcement team. • Celebration of 100yrs since the end of World War 1 – a sample of the small acrylic soldier has been received, it is very small and an alternative solution may be sought. Possibly an up-scaled oak carved version to be sited on the green during the celebration period and then permanently homed at the church or the larger sitting acrylic soldier to be placed in the church. • Church Lane Petition – a petition has been signed by the residents requesting that the hedge to the front of Martin Lodge Farm be cut back to give an improved sight line when exiting Church Lane. JP has written to Mr Turner requesting that the matter is addressed, giving 20 days from 18th April 2018.
