<p>1. Minutes The minutes of the last meeting were read and agreed.</p>	
<p>2. Matters arising</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Forester Sub-committee – A meeting was held on 21st May in Molash Village Hall. The amount of the refund due back to Molash in respect of overpayments in previous years was agreed at £275 and an exchange of cheques will take place (Refund to Molash from Challock and Molash payment of the 2018/19 interim account to Challock). Annabelle Burden is to negotiate with Fixings Warehouse to try to get them to continue with their full page colour advert. • Celebration of 100yrs since the end of World War 1 – JP has yet to make contact with Les Langley regarding a commemorative oak carving for the village. • Church Lane Petition – The Hedge at Martin Lodge Farm has been trimmed. The speed sign is still partially obscured and hence not seen until too late. AG to request that hedge at the front of Feakins Cottage is cut back to allow use of the full width of the pavement. • Volunteer Group – no further action as yet, but Pam Denereaz has volunteered herself and her car's services if required. 	<p style="text-align: center;">JP AG SW</p>
