<p><b>1. Minutes</b></p> <p>The minutes of the last meeting were read and agreed.</p> <p><b>2. Matters arising</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- <b>WW1 Commemorative Statue</b> – The plaque is now fixed in place.</li><li>- <b>Village Noticeboard</b> – has now been erected and an invoice received for this work.</li><li>- <b>Mirror</b> – has been put on its new post and promptly knocked off, presumably by a lorry. DJ advised that it wasn't angled to be of use. GW Landscaping will look at the mirror to see if it can be repaired and replaced..</li><li>- <b>A252 Speed Limit</b> – A KCC Advisory meeting to be held in Ashford on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> May. SW, KL and TD to attend.</li><li>- <b>The Woodyard, Pound Lane</b> – There have been no bonfires that we are aware of since the occupants were spoken to by ABC. Diary sheets are in circulation to record any further incidences.</li><li>- <b>Graffiti</b> – ABC representative (Colin from the Streetscene department) visited and left some removal wet-wipes to try to clean it off with. PC has a volunteer who could attempt to jet wash it off the Pound Lane barn, alternatively, it could be painted over with anti-graffiti paint. JP will clean the road signs.</li></ul> <p><b>3. Planning</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- <b>Foodari</b> – No response has been received from ABC to the email sent asking what time is allowed for them to remedy the current breach situation.</li></ul> <p><b>4. Election of Officers</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- <b>Chair</b> – Sarah Williams – Nominated by Delenda James, Seconded by Tony Dodd. Not contested, hence elected.</li><li>- <b>Vice Chair</b> – Kim Lowe– Nominated by Tony Dodd, Seconded by Delenda James. Not contested, hence elected.</li></ul>

- Advised by Ray Loftus that the name of the council employee who had been the subject of a complaint to ABC has been removed from the minutes on the website.
- Further correspondence from Challock PC stating that they regarded an advert from Sheldwich CC was regarded as community advertising and was hence free.
- Email to KCC concerning the forthcoming A252 Safer Roads Fund presentation, advising that Molash PC would be represented.
- Email from KCC Highways advising of the planned programme of works 2019/2020. Other than the cutting of verges and hedges, no works are planned for the roads in the parish.
- Declaration of Acceptance of Office and Disclosure of Pecuniary Interest Forms received from ABC and circulated to all councillors for completion.
- Forester monthly report April 2019 received from Challock, a meeting to be requested.
- PCSO monthly report – no incidents reported in Molash.
